If your RRHAN-EC has already expired or you are new to education, please refer to the following guide which will help you to determine which course you need to do.

My certificate expires on 31 December 2024 - do the online update only (takes about 2 hours).

My certificate is expired – start with the fundamentals. If you also work directly with children and young people, do the masterclass after you've finished the fundamentals course.



"Regular reading sparks creativity, inspires imagination, and develops empathy. The joy of reading can enhance the lives of our young people."

This year we have joined 670 schools in South Australia and well over 120,000 students completing the Challenge.

The Premier's Reading Challenge Certificates and Medals were given to the class teachers to distribute this week.

This year there were 272 students who completed the challenge. There were 50 certificates and 223 medals.

These included 56 Bronze medals, 55 Silver, 36 Gold, 41 Champion, 21 Legend and 14 Hall of Fame medals.

A special congratulations goes to Ava W. (6P) who completed 8 Years of PRC and received her Reader for Life certificate.

Five special awards are yet to be given out at an upcoming whole school gathering.

A great effort was made in our Reception - Year 2 classes with support by families who took on the challenge independently of the class teacher.

These included 4 Receptions, 18 Year 1s and 32 Year 2s.

This year students focused on reading a variety of authors which opened up new worlds for many of our readers.

A very special thank you to all those in school and beyond who have listened to students reading, read to them and helped them decode and comprehend words. Your encouragement in valuing the fabulous worlds that reading for both pleasure and information can take us into is invaluable.




